On April 3, 2024, UNT Police received two separate reports of electric scooters stolen from campus bicycle racks. These scooters are considered motor vehicles under the <u>Clery Act</u>. One was secured to a bicycle rack in front of Kerr Hall and the other was not secured next to a bicycle rack in front of Maple Hall. Both were reported to have been stolen within the last few days.
