UNT Police received reports of electric scooters stolen from campus bicycle racks. These scooters are considered motor vehicles under the Clery Act.

On June 23, 2026, two electric scooters were stolen from the bicycle rack in front of Clark Hall. On June 24, 2026, another electric scooter was stolen from the bicycle rack at Bruce Hall.

The UNT Police Department offers a free engraving program. To take advantage of this program, please bring your scooter and identification to the UNT Police Department. A supply of free U-Locks is expected for the fall semester.

Safety Precautions

- Immediately report suspicious or dangerous activity to the police by dialing or texting 911.
- When securing electric scooters, consider using a high-security U-lock.
- Consider attaching a GPS tracker to your scooter.
- If possible, remove your scooter's battery pack when not in use.
- Consider engraving personally identifiable numbers on the scooter in an inconspicuous place.
