UNT Police received reports this week of an electric scooter and two electric bicycles stolen from campus bicycle racks. These scooters and E-bikes are considered motor vehicles under the Clery Act.

On Aug. 16, 2026, an electric scooter was stolen from the bicycle rack in front of Sante Fe Square. On Aug. 19, 2026, two electric bicycles were stolen, one from the bicycle rack at Chestnut Hall and the other from a rack near the CVAD building.

UNT Police are continuing to investigate these cases and develop leads. If you have any information about these offenses, contact UNT Criminal Investigative Services at 940-565-3006 or remain anonymous by calling 940-369-TIPS (8477).

The UNT Police Department offers a free bicycle and scooter engraving program for students. To participate, please bring your scooter and a valid form of identification to the UNT Police Department. U-locks are available while supplies last.

Safety Precautions

- Immediately report suspicious or dangerous activity to the police by dialing 911.
- When securing electric scooters, consider using a high-security U-lock.
- Consider attaching a GPS tracker to your scooter.
- If possible, remove your scooter's battery pack when not in use.
- Consider engraving personally identifiable numbers on the scooter in an inconspicuous place.
