UNT Police have received multiple reports of stolen electric scooters and an electric bicycle from bicycle racks. These scooters are considered motor vehicles under the Clery Act.

On Aug. 18, 2025, an electric bicycle was stolen from a bike rack at the Pohl Recreation Center. The bicycle is described as a black Jasion E-Bike and was secured with a lock. A suspect was identified in the Aug, 18 case, and the E-Bike was recovered.

On Aug. 20, 2025, an electric scooter was stolen from the Bruce Hall bike rack. The scooter was described as a black and red JoyHis and was secured with a cable lock.

On Aug. 28, 2025, an electric scooter was stolen from the Eagle Student Services Center bike rack. This scooter is described as a black Jetson Ember brand electric scooter. A suspect was identified, and the scooter was recovered.

On Sept. 3, 2025, an electric scooter was stolen from a bike rack at the Pohl Recreation Center. The scooter is described as a black Hiboy S2 and was secured with a lock.
