On Oct. 30, 2024, a UNT student reported an Indecent Assault (fondling) to UNT Police. The student reported being followed by a male from the Union area to Legends Hall around 9 p.m. It was reported that the male asked the female student for her phone number and address while following her. Once inside Legends Hall, the male inappropriately touched the female on the buttocks while inside an elevator.
