

## **UNT Police Crime Alert**

Friday, June 27, 2025

On Thursday, June 26, 2025, a person reported that someone entered a shared graduate student office in the Chemistry Building, and after rummaging through several individuals' personal items, stole a wallet containing several credit and debit cards. The cards were later used to make fraudulent purchases. The suspect was later found by officers on video entering the area about noon and was described as a heavy-set black female wearing all black clothing and wearing a mask.

There have been at least two other thefts by unknown persons in recent days that may be related. UNT Police are investigating these cases.

UNT community members should be mindful that office spaces and personal items should remain secured when no one is present. Personal property such as laptop computers, etc., should not be left unattended in public spaces at any time.

### **SAFETY PRECAUTIONS:**

- Immediately report suspicious persons or dangerous activity to the police by dialing 911.
- Keep office and private area doors locked, whether the room is attended or unattended. Speak with your coworkers about room security as well (for shared spaces).
- Even while in your room, keep valuables out of sight or locked away.
